3. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.
5. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you.
6. You will be notified by mail in May regarding the status of your application.

NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited post-secondary institution.

**Purpose:** To provide scholarships to one (1) deserving New Prairie High school graduating senior interested in or intending to pursue post-high school course of study at either college/university or other post-secondary educational institution.

**Award Components:** One (1) \$1,000.00 scholarship and individual certificate awarded to one (1) student selected by Jamie Middlebrook Memorial Scholarship, Inc. Committee.

**Criteria:**

1. Applicant must be a New Prairie School District resident.
2. Applicant must be the child, orphaned child, adopted child or step-child of at least one (1) individual that serves as a full-time, part-time or volunteer first responder; such as, fire department, emergency medical service, or police department.
3. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
4. The Scholarship Committee must receive the scholarship application prior to the twenty-fifth (25<sup>th</sup>) birthday of the applicant.
5. Applicant must demonstrate positive-impact involvement – in the complete sense – consistent with capacity and circumstances and/or significant improvement/success in scholarship and community involvement, determined through letters of recommendation.

**Application Process:**

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation of career goals and biographical (background) information. The letter should also contain athletic information, if applicable, community service and other volunteer activities.
3. Three (3) letters of recommendations from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
4. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average and a class standing/rank.
5. Personal essay regarding the importance and history of community service in our area.

**Deadline** for the application is **April 30, 2016**. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
